

June 12-14, 2015



Format

Teams will be flighted by adding the low handicap twice and the high handicap once and dividing by three. There will be (Five) nine-hole better ball matches per flight. Please note that the handicaps being used are 80% of full handicap divided by two for the nine-hole matches. We will stroke off the low ball, meaning the player with the lowest handicap (in the foursome) plays with zero and the remaining players receive their handicap minus the low handicap of the foursome. The team that accumulates the most points during the five matches shall be declared the flight winner and will proceed to the Championship Playoff. Points are made as follows: the winning team of a hole makes one point; a hole tied results in a ½ point per team; the winning team of a match shall receive one point; if any team forfeits a match or any flights are uneven, their opponent will play against par using their handicap.

Any ties for flight winners will be decided by a sudden death playoff immediately following the completion of play. The playoff will start on Orange #1 and continue until the flight winner is determined. The handicap format above shall determine the number of shots each player receives.

Playoff Procedure for the 2-Man Invitational Champion

The lowest gross team and winners from all flights shall qualify for a playoff. The handicap format above shall determine the amount of shots each player receives. One team will be eliminated per hole until we are down to two teams. The lowest team scores advance to the next hole, while the team with the highest score is out. If two or more teams are tied for the high score on a hole, then a chip-off will ensue from a point around the green of the hole being played as determined by the professional staff. Both team members attempt the chip shot and the team whose closest ball is furthest away will be eliminated. The playoff will begin on Black #1 proceed to Hole #2, #8, and then #9 until a winner is determined.

Tees

Men - White Tees Women - Orange Tees Seniors (65 +) - Grey Tees (Optional and must be stated at time of registration)

Rules of Play

U.S.G.A. rules govern all play with the following exceptions:

- 1. Free drop from all French Drains "through the green"
- 2. You may move your ball one scorecard length in your own fairway no closer to the hole
- 3. Free drop from all roots "through the green"

Incomplete Rounds Due to Weather

In order to decide a flight winner, 18 holes must be completed. If a 9 hole match is unable to be completed – it will be cancelled. (If one of the 5 matches is cancelled – then the tournament will consist of only 4 matches) In the event that we are unable to complete a full 18 holes over the course of the weekend, we will reschedule the tournament for another weekend.



Pace of Play

With such a large field, pace of play will be important. Each round should take approximately 2 hours and 15 minutes to complete. Remember, only one net score will count for your team per hole, so if a player is out of the hole and can no longer help their teammate, they should pick up in order to maintain a quick pace of play.

Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to the 2 Man Invitational Champion and all the flight winners and runnerups. (You may win your flight or the overall championship, but not both.)

Team Buy-In

Two-player best ball based on Net Ball, the top 1/3 of the field gets paid each day. Players are grouped in one overall flight with payouts on Day 1, Day 2, and/or Total. A player can <u>not</u> win all three but may win two of the three Totals. (Pays 90% to winner and 10% to tournament budget)

The Big Dog

You may enter your own team in the Big Dog for \$20 per team. This fee will go directly to the Big Dog or the overall champion. If your team has not entered it will not be eligible for the Big Dog payout but may contend for the championship. (Pays 90% to winner and 10% to tournament budget)

Putting Tournament - Harnett County Food Bank

Bring a Canned Food to Participate –We are sponsoring the Harnett County Food Bank – come support a good cause and show off your putting skills

Entry fee is \$10 per team. The format is Alternate Shot. One team member will tee off the odd holes and the other team member will tee off the even holes. The players will alternate shots until the ball is holes. The payout will be based on how many teams participate.

Optional Skins Tournament - Gross and Net

\$20 Individual gross skins and \$20 net skins, this includes the individual for two days of skins. (Winners will be decided both days)
